SPRING SPECIAL CLEANUP

SUBJECT TO AVAILABILITY, OPEN-TOP DUMPSTERS WILL BE POSITIONED AND AVAILABLE TO ACCEPT HOUSEHOLD REFUSE AT THE NORTH TRANSFER STATION FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE 2021. A METAL RECYCLING DUMPSTER WILL ALSO BE AVAILABLE.

This cleanup activity is dedicated to support residents and taxpayers of Sugar Island Township with the disposal of **HOUSEHOLD ITEMS**. This activity is NOT designed to support business contractors or vendors dispose of their business-related debris. Contractors or vendors are asked to dispose of their business-related debris at an appropriate landfill on the mainland.

SPECIAL NOTE: To reduce the abuse experienced in previous years, individuals wishing to utilize this opportunity must be prepared to prove residency and eligibility. A taxpayer list will be available at the Transfer Station for validation, if necessary.

SPECIAL CLEANUP PROHIBITIONS

The following items may not be disposed of in the open-top dumpsters provided by the Sugar Island Township:

- Vehicle Batteries
- Liquid Paint, Stains, etc.
- Vehicle Fluids
- Vehicle Tires
- Appliances with Toxic Fluids
- Fluorescent Bulbs
- Construction Materials such as Asphalt Shingles, Concrete, etc.
- Ammunition & Fireworks
- Propane Tanks
- Lawn Clippings & Leaves/Brush
- Expired Medicines
- Televisions, and other Electronics
- Sharps (i.e., Needles)
- Styrofoam
- Items Containing Asbestos

SPECIAL NOTE: Debris created on the mainland should stay on the mainland. When identified, individuals attempting to dispose of debris created on the mainland at the North Transfer Station will be turned away.
